Announcement of Job Opening English Teaching Position

1 Position: Full-time faculty member

2 Rank: Professor, Associate Professor, or Lecturer

3 Number of positions: 1

4 Scheduled Date of Employment: September 1, 2023, or as soon thereafter as possible

5 Coursework and Duties:

(1) Assigned Coursework:

Oral Communication with English Pronunciation (Speech I & II)

Specialty Seminars (including graduation thesis)

Courses related to the teacher certification program

(e.g., "English Teaching Methods" and "English Speech
Communication Theory")

Other English-related courses

(2) Other duties may include:

- Managing and escorting students to short-term Study Abroad Programs
- Other duties as deemed necessary by the University, such as serving on subcommittees and performing duties related to entrance examinations.

6 Qualifications

(1) Any nationality

(2) Holders of a post-graduate degree (MA / PhD.) in English as a Second Language, Second Language Acquisition, Applied Linguistics, etc. are preferred.*

* Although holders of a post-graduate degree are preferred, any candidate with significant experience in teaching English and/or conducting relevant research will also be considered.

(3) Applicants with significant research and teaching experience at the university level are preferred (especially regarding the instruction of English pronunciation through communicative activities, or the instruction of English communication).

(4) Applicants with the following experience are desirable:

- Experiences teaching at the university level
- Experience teaching courses related to the teacher certification program
- Experience using ICT for language instruction
- Experience in English Medium Instruction (EMI).

(5) Other

- As an institution that prides itself on providing a liberal arts education, applicants must show an enthusiasm for teaching and for interacting with students in and out of the classroom.
- Successful applicants will also show an understanding that Miyazaki Municipal University is a public institution and as such places great emphasis on contributing to the local community. Applicants will also be expected to contribute to the local community whenever possible.
- The University's policy is to promote gender equality and to actively recruit women if their qualifications are deemed equal during a selection process dedicated to a fair and unbiased evaluation.

Note:

A high level of Japanese speaking ability is preferred for this position. If Japanese is not the native language of the applicant, the applicant should have the ability to use Japanese to process administrative paperwork and provide support to students in comprehensible

Japanese.

① All application documents must be completed in Japanese, and documents prepared in a foreign language must be accompanied by a Japanese translation.

② For all publications that are "in press" and yet to be published, please provide some official certification from the publisher. Attach the certificate to Form 3.

③ Please summarize the abstracts of three major papers (Form 4) in approximately 1,000 words each.

- ④ (Form 6), (Form 7) and (Form 8) should be limited to 1,000 words each.
- ⑤ Please note that submitted documents (except for "excerpts" of major papers and books) will not be returned.
- ⑥ Personal information in the application documents will not be used for any purpose other than employment screening.

9 Application deadline: Application documents must be received by 5:00 p.m. on Monday, April 3, 2023.

10 Selection process:

Upon completion of an initial screening, all applicants will be notified. Successful applicants will then have an interview on the campus of MMU tentatively scheduled for between May 20 (Sat.) and May 27 (Sat.), 2023. Following the interview, applicants will give a demonstration lesson. Details of interview and demonstration lesson will be provided later.

11 Final notification:

The successful applicant will be notified in writing after selection procedures are completed.

12 Outline of Working Conditions

- (1) Full-time faculty member
- (2) Tenure position (The retirement age of the University is 65 years old.)
- (3) Salary and allowances will be paid in accordance with the employment regulations and salary regulations of the University.

- (5) Research expenses will be paid according to each position.
